
The Dean, FoE welcomed all the Members of the Faculty of Engineering for the online meeting

1. Stability of Slopes topic to be included in the core course of Soil Mechanics shifting from Chapter 1 of Geotechnical Design Elective Course.
2. PC414 CEM course - Credits given 2, Lecture hours 3.
3. In Soil Mechanics Laboratory it is stated that 10 out of 20 experiments are to be carried out. Section I has 8 small experiments, however these small tests can be combined to reduce the number of experiments in Section I. Section II has important experiments which cannot be omitted.
4. Concrete Technology Theory and Laboratory courses – Include relevant codes and manuals in the suggested readings/reference books
5. Design of Hydraulic Structures – In Unit III change the name of Earth Dams to Earthen Dams,

14. Traffic Engineering and Road Safety content to be revised
15. Design of Irrigation Structures - To be made as core subject.

The new scheme was implemented for B.E Sem-I w.e.f. the academic year 2021-22. The Board considered and approved the same. The Chairperson has presented the Course Structure of B.E.(CSE) and B.E.(AI&DS) for III and IV Semester along with observations and suggestions to the Committee Members.

After discussion the following suggestions are made by the members:

B.E(CSE)

- Dr. B Vishnu Vardhan sir suggested to add some microprocessor programs in Computer Organization Lab.
- All the panel members suggested to uniformly maintain the number of Lab experiments for Lab courses.
- Dr.K Shyamala madam suggested to have evaluation procedure for CISCO which should be mapped with University standards.
- All the panel members suggested to increase credits for MOOCs courses
- Dr. Y Sagar sir suggested to devise a method internally for awarding credits for MOOCs courses.
- Operation research subject of III Semester CSE should be renamed as “Optimization and Problem Solving Technique”
- All the panel members suggested to have case studies in Java, Operating Systems, Computer Networks and Database Management Systems Lab.
- All the panel members suggested to add separate thread for programming and security.
- Artificial Intelligence and Data Science subjects should be interchanged and rename Data Science Lab to Data Science using R Lab.

- Panel members suggested to introduce 0 credit courses like digital money, social networking etc and engage the students in some activity like group learning, group discussion etc.
- Technical Skills Lab code should be changed from PW to PC

B.E(AI&DS)

The chairperson has taken up the discussion of AI&DS scheme after the completion of CSE scheme. The following are the suggestions:

- Computer Networks subject should be interchanged with Operating Systems subject.
- Panel members suggested to maintain uniformity in all semesters with 5 Theory and 3 Lab subjects.
- Dr.K Shyamala madam suggested to add Pipelining concepts in Computer Organization subject.
- Dr.K Shyamala madam suggested to remove Python Programming theory subject , add 1 credit and 1 extra hour for python programming lab.
- Panel members suggested to add courses related to packages like Django, Numpy etc
- Panel members suggested to introduce Digital Logic Design before Computer Organization and add it in EC code.
- Panel members asked to design IOT subject syllabus based more on sensors.
- Panel members suggested to combine Data Science and Big Data Management and add Full Stack development as core subject.
- Panel members suggested to add Automata and Compiler Design, Web 3.0 subjects.
- Dr. Atul Negi sir suggested to have data stream as one thread
- Dr. B Vishnu Vardhan sir suggested to add Social as one thread for Professional Elective.
- Panel members suggested to rearrange the threads




The meeting ended with Vote of Thanks.
