Establishment of Welfare Committee for BC / SC / ST / MINORITIES

The BC / SC / ST / MINORITIES Cell was established in the Academic year 2024-25 for the welfare of the students from the Backward Classes (BC) Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) and Minority communities in improving their academic performance and in optimizing their development in their personal and social life at the Institute. It also helps the BC / SC / ST / MINORITY categories to integrate with the mainstream of the institute community and to remove difficulties, which they may be experiencing. The committee ensures equality among all the students by counselling and to optimally utilise the benefits of the schemes offered by the Government of India.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. Counseling and Guidance: Provide academic, personal, and emotional counseling to BC, SC, ST, and minority students to help them navigate college life and address any issues effectively.
 - 2. Scholarship and Financial Support: Inform students about available scholarships from state governments, UGC, and other sources, and assist them in accessing financial support.
 - 3. Access to Facilities: Ensure students have access to necessary facilities, such as hostels and books, provided by central and state governments, and facilitate their utilization.
 - 4. Grievance Redressal and Protection: Establish mechanisms for addressing grievances, ensuring protection, and ensuring students' rights as per the Constitution, including reservation policies.
 - 5. Career and Personal Development: Promote career orientation programs, remedial coaching, life skills development, and personality enhancement to help students improve academic performance and future career prospects.
- 6. Data Collection and Reporting: Regularly collect and analyze data on admissions of BC, SC, ST, and minority students across various courses to monitor progress and fulfill government objectives.
