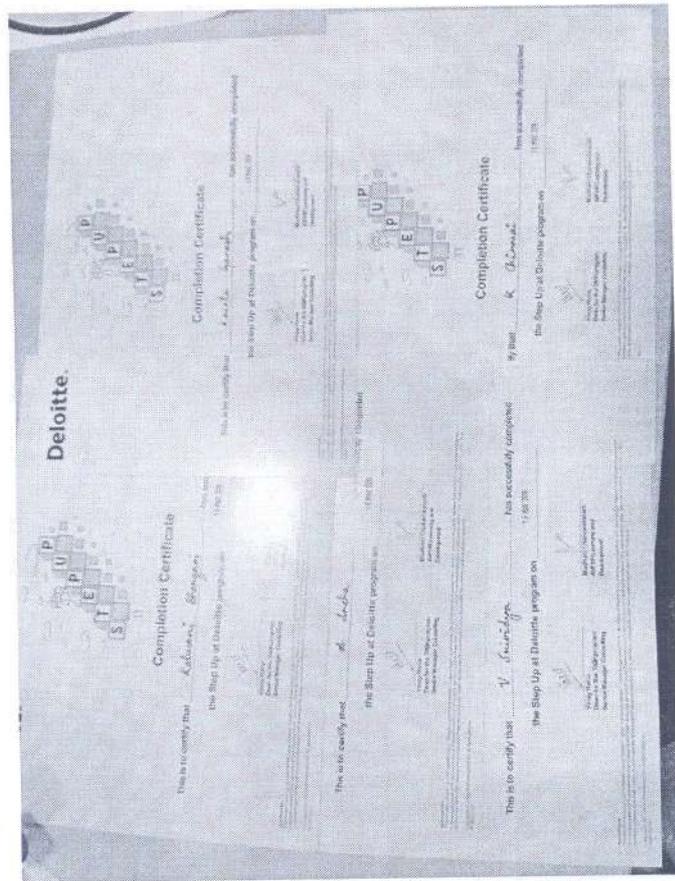
2 students from ECE did not attend the program.
