




  
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4. Each project sanctioned by AICTE is assigned a specific Ref. No. given on the pre-page. All correspondences related to the project must contain this number along with year of sanction of the project, failing which correspondence will not be entertained.
5. The accounts of the grantee which are liable to be audited by the Council or Comptroller and Audited General of India or by any Officer designated for the purpose.
6. The institute/University shall not charge any overheads on this project and will provide all the administrative support for completion of the project.
7. The grantee shall utilize grants on only approved items of expenditure (list enclosed). However in case the grantee wishes to recast the project, approval of the Council must be obtained for the revised item of expenditure and they will maintain proper accounts of the expenditure as per the norms/procedures of AICTE/Government of India.
8. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of All India Council for Technical Education's grant shall not be disposed or encumbered or utilize for the purpose other than those for which the Grant was given without proper sanction of the All India Council for Technical Education and should at any time the institution cease to function, such assets shall revert to the All India Council for Technical Education.
9. The grantee shall maintain an audited record of assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant-in-aid and a register or assets shall be maintained by the Institute in the prescribed form i.e. GFR-19.
10. Interest on the sanctioned grant-in-aid will be treated as part of the grant and shall be used for project purposes only and the same shall be mentioned in the audited statement of accounts.
11. Since the duration of the project is for one year, the request for reimbursement of 20% of remaining amount shall be made with UC and other related documents in such a way that the entire project is completed in the prescribed period of one year.
12. The Annual Progress Report in the prescribed format along with Statement of Expenditure and Audited Utilization Certificate shall be submitted to AICTE not later than one month after completion.
13. Project Completion Report (PCR) in the prescribed format along with the Audited Statement of Expenditure indicating expenditure incurred in the total duration of the project in the prescribed format, utilization in the format and GFR-19 shall be submitted to the Council.
14. The Utilization Certificate (UC) supported by Audited Statement of Expenditure to the effect that the grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to the All India Council for Technical Education immediately after completion of the project. It should contain the head-wise break up of expenditure made from the grant-in-aid provided by the Council.







With reference to your application for the **Maulana Azad National Fellowship for Minority Students**, I am happy to inform you that based on the recommendations of the Expert Committee; the UGC has selected you for the **Maulana Azad National Fellowship for Minority Students**, for the year **2015-16**.

The tenure of the fellowship is for five years and it commences w.e.f. 1.4. 2015 (**or**) from the date of Registration under M.Phil / Ph.D. (**or**) from the date of joining in M.Phil / Ph.D. programme, **whichever is later**. The other requirements and details of the Scheme is enclosed as [Annexure-I](#). The summary of the financial assistance offered under the Scheme are as follows:

1.	Amount of Fellowship (For All Subjects)	@ Rs.25,000/- per month for initial two years (JRF), @ Rs.28,000/- per month for the remaining tenure (SRF)

3.	Contingency (For Sciences and Engineering & Technology)	@ Rs.12,000/- per annum for initial two years, @ Rs.25,000/- per annum for remaining three years.
4.	Escorts / Reader Assistance	@ Rs.2,000/- per month in case of physically and visually challenged candidates.
5.	HRA	As per University / Institution rules.

The awardee is required to get admission and registration for **regular** and **full time M.Phil / Ph.D.** course in a University / Institution recognized by the UGC at the first available opportunity **but not later than two years** from the date of issue of this award letter. Kindly note that this period is not extendable under any circumstances. It may also be noted that the admission to M.Phil / Ph.D. should be taken by fulfilling the conditions of admission of the University / Institution concerned subject to the provision of the scheme as per advertisement of UGC.

It may be noted that the fellowship amount shall be disbursed through Bank to be identified/notified by Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India, New Delhi to the bank account of the awardee, (any bank) directly. The list of designated branches of Bank will be available on the ministry's portal. The awardee is required to approach the designated branch along with a Copy of the Award Letter and Joining Report with photograph, address and contact no. in the prescribed proforma. The awardee is also required to submit the following documents to the designated branch of the Bank at the stipulated period interval:

1. At the end of every three months a 'Continuation Certificate' in the prescribed proforma. [Annexure-III](#). This will make the awardee eligible to draw the fellowship for the next three months.
2. Half yearly submission of Progress report in the prescribed proforma [Annexure-IV](#) along with the 'Continuation Certificate'.
3. Details of the expenditure incurred out of the contingency grant to be submitted annually in the prescribed proforma. [Annexure-V](#).
4. The claim towards HRA is subject to the submission of HRA certificate in the prescribed proforma [Annexure-](#)

5. After the completion of two years of award of fellowship an 'Upgradation Certificate' need to be submitted in the prescribed proforma [Annexure-VII](#) along with Progress Report and Continuation Certificate.


It may be noted that UGC has proposed to link "AADHAAR" with student's bank accounts numbers so that there can be direct cash transfer and effective disbursal of fellowship into the bank account of the student. 2.3 The concerned Institution should review the performance of the Fellow after two years through an appropriate Review Committee constituted by the Head of the Institution. The fellowship in the slab after 2 years of research experience may be provided after successful assessment by the Review Committee.

2.3 Such revision in rates would also be applicable to other Government and Government Aided Institutions funded by AICTE and UGC. However, no salary grant or any other salary grant would be given to any of the Institutes for implementing the Scheme.

2.4 Sponsored and Self-Financed Category of students including those in receipt of any other similar assistantship/scholarship/fellowship would not be eligible for assistantship/scholarship/fellowship under the revised scheme. Further, the assistantship/scholarship/fellowship would be provided to the scholars on the basis of GATE scores above the prescribed cut-off level. B.Tech. Graduates from the IITs getting a CGPA score of 8 or above (on scale of 10) would also be entitled to the assistantship without having to appear in GATE.

2.5 The stipend of research fellow/associate is exempted from the payment of income tax under Section 10(16) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

### 3. Service Conditions:

3.1 **DA and CCA:** JRFs, SRFs, Research Associates and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Design will not be entitled to these allowances.

3.2 **House Rent Allowance (HRA):** All research fellows and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Design may be provided hostel accommodation wherever available and those residing in accommodation provided by the Institute will not be eligible for drawing HRA. Wherever provision of hostel accommodation is not possible, HRA may be allowed to JRF, SRF as per Central Government norms applicable in the city/location where they are working. The fellowship amount may be taken as basic for calculating the HRA.

3.3 **Leave and other entitlement benefits:** The JRFs, SRFs and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Design are eligible only for casual leave. Participation of any of these categories in any scientific event/workshop in India or abroad will be treated as 'Duty'. The travel entitlement for JRF/SRF/M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Design for participation in scientific events/workshops in India will continue to be same as earlier, i.e. 2<sup>nd</sup> AC by rail. Maternity Leave as per Government of India instructions issued from time to time would be available to female candidates in all categories.

3.4 **Bonus and Leave Travel Concessions:** JRFs and SRFs and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Design will not be entitled to these allowances.

3.5 **Retirement Benefits:** JRFs, SRFs and M.E./M.Tech/MS/M.Design will not be entitled to these benefits.

4. **Publication/Patent:** The results of JRF/SRF/M.E./M.Tech/ MS/M.Design research work may be published in standard referred journals at the discretion of the Fellow or his Guide. It should be ensured by the Fellow that the assistance provided by the funding agency of Government of India is acknowledged in all such publications.

5. **Encouragement for pursuing higher degrees:** Students selected as JRF/SRF may be encouraged to register for higher degrees and the tuition fees to undertake these studies may be reimbursed to the students from the contingency grant sanctioned under the project grant, if required.

6. **Obligations of JRF/SRF:**


- (i) He/She shall be governed by the disciplinary regulations of the host Institute where he/she is working.
- (ii) The JRF/SRF/M.E./M.Tech/ MS/M.Design must send a detailed consolidated report of the research work done during the entire period of Fellowship on completion of the tenure/resignation of the Fellowship at the earliest.

7. **Date of Effect:** The revision in emoluments comes into effect from 01.02.2015 for all categories of JRF/SRF/M.E./M.Tech/ MS/M.Design.

8. The additional cost on account of this revision may be met by the individual Institutes from out of their existing budgetary grant without any additionality in the current financial year, 2014-15. During the next financial year, 2015-16, the expenditure on this account may be capped at the current year's level and also within the given allocation, without any additionality.
